Dhondup Wangchen was arrested in 2008 for making a documentary on present-day life in Tibet. He is now serving a six-year prison sentence in a labor camp in Xilling, Qinghai, China. His case was adopted by Amnesty International and Reporters Sans Frontiers, who are campaigning for his release.

His 28-minute film, "Leaving Fear Behind," has moved audiences around the world and will be shown, followed by a Q&A with Lhamo Tso, Wangchen's wife and the mother of four children. She has traveled extensively to raise awareness of her husband's situation.
